
CHESAPEAKE AND DELAWARE, LLC BLACK RIVER RAILROAD SYSTEM

Track shall be gauged to 56-1/2".



For guidance in new construction and upgrades:

- 1. Typical layout for public grade crossing where no turnouts or other special track or structures exist.
- 2. Seventy-two (72) foot crossing rails shall not contain any joints and any welds shall be ground smooth.
- 3. Rail staggers shall be 6-feet and oriented for best connection with existing and remaining track.
- 4. Standard joints shall be new or #1 relay 6-hole bars for 1-1/8" bolts and match the section of rail.
- 5. IJs shall be new 6-hole encapsulated bars and shall match the section of rail.
- 6. The IJs closest to the crossing shall not be less than 50' from sidewalk, curb, or edge of roadway.
- 7. Compromise bars shall be new and shall match the sections of rail being connected.
- 8. Worn rail at Compromise joints shall be built up with weld and ground for smooth transition.
- 9. All materials shall be made in the USA, with providence.
- 10. It is desired that cropped rail in existing track beyond the Compromise joints be at least 13' long.
